The table shows the absolute number of permanently housed young people who were living on the street before receiving assistance from Off Road Kids. The table also shows the absolute number of young people whose personal living situation has been stabilised and are therefore not homeless due to crisis interventions or clarification of the familial environment performed by Off Road Kids.

In any given year under review, some individuals will be counted two or more times in the addition of the monthly results. This is due to the repeated placement of recurrent individuals of a period of two or more months. This multiple counts are adjusted by deducting the number of reoccurring cases each month. Multiple housing placements of a young person within one particular month will be counted as one single placement.

#### Notes:

- Comparative data is only available from 2006, because the street social work stations in Dortmund, Hamburg and Cologne were opened in 2005.
- Young people who go back out onto the street are documented monthly. These numbers are not included in the figure above
- The effective radius of the Dortmund street social work station covers the entire Ruhr area as far as Duisburg.
